Thank you for your 2020 membership in the North Carolina Women's Golf Association, Inc. Your membership fee entitles you to participate in many events that the NCWGA sponsors for all skill and enjoyment levels.

Our most notable event is the **Amateur Championship** which is held in late spring or early summer at various golf courses around the state. This Championship consist of 54 holes of stroke play, using different tee boxes for different skill levels. After 36 holes all participants are flighted. The field consists of the 96 or so lowest handicap entries and ties. Awards are given to the Champion, Runner Up, Senior Champion, Super Senior Champion, Junior Champion, Medalist and winners in each flight. Each spring, the NCWGA hosts the ever increasing in popularity and fun...the **Team Net Tournament**. The purpose of this tournament is to provide a fun four-person team net event for women of all skill levels. What a fun time for a "girl's" time together doing what they enjoy. Check our website for details and start putting your team together and come join the fun!

Something you can do at your own club is also available to you as a member of NCWGA. It's the **State Play-Day Tournament**. This is a handicap tournament played at your own club on a day of your club's choosing. The woman with the lowest net score is the winner. The winner from each club that participants receives a State Play-Day medal for her accomplishment, and she is honored with an inscription on the NCWGA State Play-Day Plaque that is provided to your club. The woman with the lowest score from all participating clubs is named the State Play-Day Champion and is honored on our website.

One of our emphasis is promoting golf for junior girls in North Carolina. We support programs which benefit the largest number of girls. With the generous assistance and support of NCWGA member clubs, individual members and golf professionals, we are able to provide reduced entry fees, clinics during the year, golf programs etc. for junior girls. The easiest way for clubs to donate to this worthy cause is to participant in the “**Pennies Per Stroke**” play-day. Designate one day of ladies play days at your club as PPS day. Just donate one penny for every stroke you have that day and your ladies have had fun and helped junior girls as well.

We also have a “**Golfund**” when you can donate and include a memorial or honorary to anyone of your choice. What a nice way to honor our women friends in golf.
